# DAY 1 - Between Neive and Barbaresco

## 1 Coazzolo

Near the small town of Coazzolo, on the top of a hill lies the Church of **Beata Maria Vergine del Carmine**. The now famous Church is often referred to as The Moscato Chapel can be considered a true work of art today.

The idea was the coazzolo Silvano Stella who decided to contact the British artist **David Tremlett** and share with him the vision of a work that would integrate with the surrounding landscape. Thus, this small church surrounded by vineyards has been given new life. Tremlett used three main colours for his work: yellow, a warm sienna and olive green. These shades fit perfectly into the scenery in which it is immersed, creating a combination of nature and art.

## 2 Neive



Medieval village with strong influences of the Roman era. Once you reach the center of Neive, you can admire the **bell tower** that rises on the edge of the village. The entrance to one of the most beautiful villages in Italy, is the door of **San Rocco**. Walking through the old town, you can see the **clock tower**.

# DAY 2 - Alba and surroundings

## 1 Alba

Nestled in the beautiful natural scenery of the Langhe, of which it is the historical and economic capital, Alba is a city rich in culture, history and traditions. It is the ancient **Alba Pompeia** from the pre-Roman origins, rich in archaeological finds and testimonies of its glorious past.

Once you arrive in Alba, you can take a walk in the historic center, you will pass by **Piazza Risorgimento**, where there is the **Cathedral of San Lorenzo** (Romanesque-Gothic style).

In the same square is the Town Hall, which is built on the remains of Roman walls.

All year round every second and fourth Sunday and every first and third Saturday of the month, plus many other extraordinary dates on the occasion of the main city events and holidays, not to be missed in Alba is the visit to the remains of the original Alba Pompeia

In Piazza **Michele Ferrero**, you can see the large sculpture of the famous **Valerio Berruti**. A statue of almost 13 meters in stainless steel bronze. The statue is called Alba (literally sunrise), Berruti explains: "it's the part of the day that I prefer: the one in which everything has yet to happen, just like during childhood".

Alba is known worldwide for its **International White Truffle Fair** ([www.fieradeltartufo.org](http://www.fieradeltartufo.org)) which takes place from October to early December.

In the **Cortile della Maddalena**, a complex that overlooks the central street (via Vittorio Emanuele II), there is **Mudet | Alba UNESCO Creative City** ([www.visitalba.eu/mudet](http://www.visitalba.eu/mudet)) where you can discover the fascinating world of truffles.



The Alba **market** is set up every Saturday morning along the streets of the center (Piazza Risorgimento, via Cavour, via Vittorio Emanuele, Piazza Marconi and Piazza Garibaldi).

### **The sensory garden of the Langhe- Ancàlte**

Ancàlte (a Piedmontese term used to describe daring, trying, and risking) , is an invitation to go beyond your own fears, your own blocks and feel free, in respect of yourself and others. A project with the aim of listening, sensing, activating the senses and acting, transcending its own boundaries. Outdoor activities, to train both the body and mind through breathing, balance and sensory experiences involving the 5 senses:

2,200 square meters of wellness, more than 60 plants, 1 synergistic garden, 1 sensory path, 1 outdoor work station, 1 meditation area, 1 outdoor training space, 1 diving pool

## 2 Grinzane Cavour

Leaving Alba in the direction of Barolo, you will arrive at **Grinzane Cavour**. The name of the small village pays homage to the **Count Camillo Benso**, a politician, patriot and entrepreneur from Italy, who was mayor of Grinzane.

The town is dominated by the imposing **medieval castle** (since 2014 UNESCO World Heritage), in which the world auction of the White Truffle of Alba takes place every year.

The castle is home to the **Enoteca Regionale Piemontese Cavour**, the first in Piedmont and the second in Italy and the **Langhe Museum**. In addition, at the foot of the castle, you can visit the **Open-Air Museum**.

# DAY 3 - The areas of Barolo

## 1 Serralunga d'Alba

Serralunga d'Alba is a charming village located in the heart of the Langhe. With its narrow streets, stone houses and panoramic views of the surrounding vineyards and hills, declared a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. The most interesting point is the **Castle of Serralunga**, a medieval fortress that dominates the landscape and offers spectacular views.

For wine lovers, Serralunga is a must-see. The country is part of the production area of **Barolo**, one of the most valuable wines in the world. You can visit some of the local wineries, where you can taste wines and learn the secrets of winemaking.

A walk in the center of the village allows you to discover also fascinating churches, such as the **Church of San Giovanni Battista**, and panoramic views that give unique emotions.

Serralunga d'Alba is also the ideal starting point to explore the surrounding hills, perfect for walks, bike rides and tours on Vespa.

## 2 Barolo



The picturesque wine country is not only renowned for its beauty and history, but it is also the birthplace of one of the world's most prized wines, **Barolo**. This wine, revered as the king of wines and the wine of kings, brings centuries of tradition and enological passion.

In the centre of this charming village stands the imposing **Castello Falletti**, a symbol of the region and the beating heart of the local wine culture. Since 2010, this castle has been transformed into the **WiMu**, the wine museum. Here, visitors can fully immerse themselves in the world of wine, exploring the intrinsic link between man and this noble drink. ## 3 *La Morra*

After having traveled a road of hairpin bends, you arrive at La Morra, also called the Balcony of the Langhe. Not to be missed is the belvedere in **Piazza Castello** where the municipal tower is located. The landscape ranges on hills cultivated with vines and castles on the tops.

Not far from the square of the Town Hall is the Wine Cellar Welcome to the [Cantina Comunale di La Morra](http://www.cantinalamorra.com) (www.cantinalamorra.com), with exhibitions and cultural events.



Outside the historic centre, stands a chapel with very bright colors, nicknamed the **Barolo Chapel**. Built in 1914 to offer shelter to winegrowers, later in 1999, it was reinterpreted by two internationally renowned artists: **Sol LeWitt** and **David Tremlett**, for an initiative of the Ceretto family.

An experience not to be missed is the **Cedro del Libano**: an evergreen conifer that can be found in Frazione Annunziata di La Morra. The tree, planted in 1856, is a breathtaking view. It is kept by the Cordero farm of Montezemolo.

## 4 *Verduno*

The visit of Verduno "The sentinel of the Langhe" will take you to a small village. In a panoramic position, the entire old town is built around the Castle, where today inside there is a hotel, a restaurant and a winery. A glass of **Verduno Pelaverga**, a small wine pearl from the Pelaverga piccolo grape variety, is highly recommended.

It is also amazing its **viewpoint**, both for the panorama that offers and for the unusual natural context for a village of this size.

# DAY 4 - The Roero

## 1 Govone

Country well visible from afar, here stands out the great **castle of Solaro**. The castle of Govone, was rebuilt by the counts Solaro, but in 1972, when the last Solaro died without heirs, the castle passed into the hands of the Savoy, who transformed it into a luxurious residence. It was also the summer residence of King Carlo Felice and his wife Maria Cristina di Borbone, who took care of a further renovation. The castle is now owned by the Municipality and since 1997 it is a UNESCO World Heritage site, along with the other Piedmontese residences of the Savoy. The royal apartments are open every Sunday from spring to autumn.

## 2 Guarene



Small village perched on a hill overlooking the river Tanaro, here you can admire the majestic **Provana Castle**, a splendid example of architecture and art of the 18th century, surrounded by a pretty Italian garden. Today Private hotel.

Guarene has several **panoramic points** overlooking the Langhe and Roero. One of these is the hill of **San Licerio**, on the border with the village of Castagnito, **open-air museum** always open to visitors realized by the Fondazione Sandretto Re Rebaudengo.

## 3 Bra

Bra is one of the major centres of Piedmontese **baroque**. The Piazza Caduti per la Libertà, in whose centre stands the statue of Giuseppe Cottolengo, is located in the oldest part of the city center. Walking the streets that start from this square, you can admire the chapel of **Santo Rosario** and **Palazzo Traversa**. The latter is an example of a stately home: it was built by the Malabaila, a family of bankers. The **Museum of History and Art** has been set up by the Municipality. Do not miss the visit to the church of **Santa Chiara**, a rococo masterpiece built in 1748. Thanks to the numerous openings, the wonderful frescoed dome is very bright.

**Cheese** - International exhibition dedicated to cheeses. The event, organized by **Slow Food** and Città di Bra, brings together over 400 exhibitors from Italy, Europe and the USA and takes place once every two years in September.

## 4 The "Rocche" of Roero

The "Rocche" of Roero is a fascinating system of hills characterized by spectacular geological formations. This area offers a landscape of great beauty, with its steep slopes, woods and vineyards that alternate in a mosaic of colors. The Rocche are the result of a geological phenomenon of erosion over centuries, which has given rise to real **canyons** deep more than one hundred meters.

Among the most suggestive places to visit, there are the **Castle of Montà**, which dominates the valley, and the villages of Santo Stefano Roero and Monteu Roero, enchanting starting points for exploring the rocks. Here you can hike along the trails that climb the hills, enjoying the breathtaking views and discovering the local flora and fauna.



For wine and food lovers, the Roero is famous for its wines, especially the **Roero Arneis**, a fresh and fragrant white, and the **Roero Rosso**. You can visit the local wineries for tastings and discover the wine making process. There are also food and wine routes offering typical dishes of the Piedmont tradition.

In summary, the Rocche del Roero are an ideal destination for those looking for a mix of nature, history, outdoor sports and good food, in a territory still little known but with unspoilt charm. ## 5 Canale

Canale is the most important agricultural center for all the products of the area: grapes, wines, fruits and especially peaches. In the middle of the town is the Town Hall Square, where stands the church of San Giovanni, with adjacent the 14th century civic tower. Canale is the home of trade throughout the Roero, and today it is the most important fruit and vegetable market in the area.

In Via Roma, you will find the **Enoteca Regionale del Roero** ([www.enotecadelroero.it](http://www.enotecadelroero.it)), which displays the labels of over 100 producers. On the first floor is the renowned restaurant All'Enoteca by chef Davide Palluda.

# DAY 5 - The Monferrato

## 1 Canelli

A town in the province of Asti located on the border between Monferrato, Asti and Langhe. Unesco heritage area, famous in the world for the **sparkling Asti D.o.c.g.** A sweet **wine**, the first Italian sparkling wine, invented by Carlo Gancia in the mid-1800s.

What to see in Canelli?

### - The Underground Cathedrals

Very long tunnels and galleries dug into the tuff hills between the sixteenth and nineteenth centuries with very particular characteristics. Inside, there are the ideal conditions for aging the finest wines and sparkling wines: humidity is constant and temperatures always remain around 12-14 degrees.

To this day, the finest labels of the most famous Canelli wineries still mature there.

To visit the Underground Cathedrals there are 4 possibilities, linked to four wineries:

### - The "Stèrnia"

The "Stèrnia" is the ancient cobblestone walkway that connects the historic center of Canelli to the castle at the top of the hill. The most important churches of the city overlook this path, which also represent the most significant architectural examples. The **Lovers' Walk** runs along the Stèrnia path. This romantic itinerary is an open-air art gallery.

### - Gancia Castle

On the top of the hill, dominating Canelli, is Gancia Castle. Built in the Middle Ages as a defensive bastion, in the 1900s it became the residence of the Gancia family who still lives there.

### - The Contini Tower

This ancient watchtower is nestled among the Moscato vineyards. To reach it, you have to climb a steep dirt road. The view from up there opens up to 360° on the hills of Langhe and Monferrato and on the clearest days reaches the peaks of the Alps and the Ligurian Apennines. Through two spiral staircases you reach two balconies and the view expands even more.



## 2 L'Art Park La Court

About 15 minutes from Canelli and 30 minutes from Neive, in the village of **Castelnuovo Calcea** is the **Art Park La Court**, inside the Michele Chiarlo wine estate. A real museum in the vineyard that celebrates human work and the wonder of nature which, together, are able to bear extraordinary fruits. The journey inside the Art Park is guided by works by numerous artists including **Ugo Nespolo**.

The works and structures of the Park can be visited independently, by downloading the **LA COURT AUDIOGUIDE App**.

At the end of this journey into art, we recommend a visit to **Michele Chiarlo**, in **Calamandrana**, where the grapes are processed.

Another recommended activity is the **picnic among the vineyards** of La Court, which includes the collection of the packed lunch at the Calamandrana Cellar with consumption wherever you want, but preferably in the vineyard!

Reservations are required and include a choice of a picnic bag or a backpack which, in addition to containing wine and gourmet packed lunch, also include a towel, corkscrew and glasses.

At Castello di Annone (province of Asti) Barbara and Lorenzo have created a collaboration with dairy producers, selecting the best local cheeses. In the historic centre of Asti, the workshop is located a few kilometers from the laboratory and the aging cellars in the heart of Monferrato. The personal ageing they follow serves to develop the aromas, taste and texture that each cheese has as its intrinsic characteristic from the moment of its production. Respecting the potential of the raw material that has been carefully chosen to enhance every aspect is what refining means. ## *Transport services to Langhe Country House*

### **CONTRASPORTO**

It is a call-in transport service between public transport and taxis.

How does it work?

You book your trip and the bus comes to pick you up from Langhe Country House.

On the way to your destination, the minibus will pick up other people who are in the vicinity of your route.

The bus will make a journey designed to be the fastest to serve all the passages ensuring everyone arrives on time to their destination.
